**FIFTY** years ago Julia and Ghede Pusey, sisters from Perth appeared together alternating the lead role in Carmen at the National Theatre in Melbourne.

Both classically trained singers, Julia and Ghede had local and international success in the 50s through to the 70s. Motherhood and family commitments had them step out of the spotlight professionally for an interval of some years.

However, during this time Julia developed into a fine artist and has been painting in all styles and mediums for over 40 years, having held dozens of exhibitions throughout Victoria.



Ghede continued performing in Melodrama and Pantomime for many years before taking up pottery and sculpture.
